## Wonder! The Learning

### Leviticus 26:3-13

**Series objective:** *To help us see from Genesis to Revelation that God's Big Story is that He wants to be with us and He wants us to be with Him.*

### Learnings from Leviticus

\***The importance of** \_\_\_\_\_. Provided through directions on how to give offerings (Ch. 1–7)

\***The necessity of a** \_\_\_\_\_. Provided by the initiation of the Priesthood as Aaron and sons were ordained (Ch. 8–10)

\***The plan to stay** \_\_\_\_\_. Provided through laws of cleanliness (Ch. 11–15)

\***The seriousness of** \_\_\_\_\_. Provided through directions on atonement for sin (Ch. 16–17)

\***The guidelines for** \_\_\_\_\_. Provided through directions on how to be a holy culture (Ch. 18–27)

**Leviticus 20:26** - You are to be holy to me because I, the Lord, am holy, and I have set you apart from the nations to be my own.

### A hinge point in God's big story:

*You don't have to change for God to love you. But you will need to change in order to \_\_\_\_\_.*

### The two requirements for living the "with God" life:

1. \_\_\_\_\_ = God demonstrating His love for us by dying an atoning death.

**Colossians 2:13b-14** - He forgave us all our sins, having canceled the charge of our legal indebtedness, which stood against us and condemned us; he has taken it away, nailing it to the cross.

**Justified** = *Just as if I'd* \_\_\_\_\_ *sinned.*

2. \_\_\_\_\_ = Us demonstrating our love for God by living a holy life.

**John 14:21** - Whoever has my commands and keeps them is the one who loves me. The one who loves me will be loved by my Father, and I too will love them and show myself to them.

**Sanctified** = *I live on the outside how I look to God on the* \_\_\_\_\_.

**1 John 2:5b-6** - This is how we know we are in him: Whoever claims to live in him must live as Jesus did.

**Hebrews 10:14** - For by one sacrifice he has made perfect forever those who are being made holy.

**Holiness is** \_\_\_\_\_.

**Matthew 7:13-14** - Enter through the narrow gate. For wide is the gate and broad is the road that leads to destruction, and many enter through it. But small is the gate and narrow the road that leads to life, and only a few find it.
