Ephesians 6:10-13 - 10 Finally, be strong in the Lord and in His mighty power. 11 Put on the full armor of God, so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes. 12 For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the HEAVENLY REALMS. 13 Therefore put on the full armor of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground, and after you have done everything, to stand.

<p><u>Critical Capabilities</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Power of an Arch Angel • 1/3 of the angels, now demons • Lots of followers who unwittingly or deliberately discourage Christians • Pride, Questioning God, Deceive • Will fight to the death • Tremendous Power, more than us 	<p><u>Center of Gravity – Motivation</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Steal, Kill, and Destroy YOU! • Take as Many people to HELL with him in his last stand
<p><u>Critical Requirements</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Demons • Humans who follow him • Ability to tempt where it counts • Whatever it takes to gets you off balance and cease trusting God • Willing accomplices 	<p><u>Critical Vulnerabilities</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A Created Being • Cannot be everywhere at once • Doom is Sure • A Defeated Enemy • Limited Power compared to God

God's Objectives – Plan, Goal

<p><u>Critical Capabilities</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All Powerful, Eternal • Exists in Three Persons Who are in Complete Agreement • Creator, Ruler, Redeemer • Lots of followers who will partner with Him to make Disciples • Ultimate Power and Authority • Justice and Love Rms. 3:21-26 	<p><u>Center of Gravity – Motivation</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Give Life, Life Abundantly • For People to Love Him because He 1st Loved them • Take as many people to HEAVEN as will accept Him
<p><u>Critical Requirements</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Without Sin, Obedient to Death • A Savior • Power to Defeat Satan • The Cross, Power over sin • The Resurrection, Power over death • Draw people to Him • Full Authority over the Universe 	<p><u>Critical Vulnerabilities</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Will People Follow Him? • Will People see His power and authority over the heavenly realms? • Will People Trust, Believe? • Will People Endure? • Risks that people will let His will surpass their own
