* **An Unthinkable _____**

Genesis 22:2 - Then God said, "Take your son, your only son, whom you love—Isaac—and go to the region of Moriah. Sacrifice him there as a burnt offering on a mountain I will show you."

* **Imagine the mental, spiritual & emotional _____ Abraham must have gone through.**

* **An Unbelievable _____**

Genesis 22:3 - Early the next morning Abraham got up and loaded his donkey. He took with him two of his servants and his son Isaac. When he had cut enough wood for the burnt offering, he set out for the place God had told him about.

* **You come to _____ God by experience as you obey Him and He accomplishes His work through you.**

Genesis 22:9-10 - When they reached the place God had told him about, Abraham built an altar there and arranged the wood on it. He bound his son Isaac and laid him on the altar, on top of the wood. Then he reached out his hand and took the knife to slay his son.

* **An Unforeseeable _____**

Genesis 22:13 - Abraham looked up and there in a thicket he saw a ram caught by its horns. He went over and took the ram and sacrificed it as a burnt offering instead of his son.

Genesis 22:14 - So Abraham called that place **The Lord Will Provide**. And to this day it is said, "On the mountain of the Lord it will be provided."

* **Why is 'Jehovah-Jireh' important to us today?**

1. It shows us that a faithful, unchanging God keeps His word and therefore can be implicitly _____.

Numbers 23:19 - God is not human, that He should lie, not a human being, that He should change His mind. Does He speak and then not act? Does He promise and not fulfill?

** If God kept His word to Abraham over 1500 years after the events on Mount Moriah, He still keeps His word now.*

2. It informs us that God has the _____ to our deepest need – "How can I be right with God?"

** Ever since the garden of Eden, all people have needed a sacrifice to bring them into a correct relationship with God.*

John 1:29b - Behold! The lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world.

** 2000 years ago on a cross outside Jerusalem, Jesus provided the provision for our acceptance before God.*

Romans 5:8 - But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

Romans 8:32 - He who did not spare his own Son, but gave Him up for us all—how will He not also, along with Him, graciously give us all things?
