The Parable of Intentional Vs. Lazy Steward Matthew 25:14-28

Summary: A master entrusts his servants with different amounts of money, or resources, before going on a journey. Two of the servants are intentional and double the amount they were given, while the third servant, who is lazy, buries his talent with no ROI. When the master returns, he commends the first two servants for their faithful use of the resources but is clearly disappointed with the third servant for not using his resources appropriately.
