## Remember Verse

**Casting all your anxieties on him, because he cares for you.  
1 Peter 5:7**

## Puzzle

### SUPPLIES

- Remember Verse Puzzle
- Scissors
- Optional
  - glue
  - paper

### DIRECTION

1. Print off the remember verse puzzle
  2. Cut it out. (If you have older children, you can cut it into smaller pieces)
  3. Children may try to put the puzzle back together
- Optional - Once you have the puzzle together, you can glue it onto another piece of paper

## Game for Remember Verse

### The Tricky Parent

Repeat the verse with your child several times so that they are familiar with it. Then, say the verse aloud to them, but make a mistake. When your child hears the mistake, they call out "Gotcha" and get one point. If your child doesn't catch the error, the "Tricky Parent" gets a point.

**Multiple children?** Play this game in exactly the same way, pitting the children against a parent to see who gets the most points.

## Word Search Options

1. You may use a timer and see how many words they find in 3 or 5 minutes
2. You may wish to have a race to see who can finish first.
  - a. Kids vs parents
  - b. Child vs child

# Coloring Page - Jesus Walking on the Water


- Use watercolor paints and paint brushes, crayons, or markers to color the picture
- **Or, for something different:**

## SUPPLIES

- Coloring page
- Crayons
- Corn syrup
- Blue food coloring
- Something for a messy mat - cookie tray, parchment paper or cardboard
- Paint brush (optional)

## DIRECTIONS

- a. Print a picture on cardstock (If you don't have cardstock, print out on copy paper and glue onto a piece of cardboard (a cereal box would work).
- b. Color just the boat, disciples and Jesus with crayons.
- c. Use a little bit of corn syrup and blue food coloring. Mix together in a small bowl or cup
- d. They can you use a paintbrush or their fingers to paint the water with the corn syrup
- e. This takes a while to dry. When dry, it will look shiny, like water!




# Jesus Walking on the Water Craft

## SUPPLIES

- Jesus Walks on the Water coloring page
- Scissors
- Crayons / markers
- Tape
- Craft stick or a piece of cardboard cut into the size of a craft stick

## DIRECTIONS

1. Print off Jesus- walks- on- water - craft PDF file onto cardstock.  
*(If you don't have card stock, print out on regular paper, cut it out, glue it onto a paper plate or a piece of thin cardboard - example a cereal box)*
2. Cut the slit (parents may need to do this for the kids)
3. Color the picture and Jesus
4. Tape Jesus onto the back of the craft stick or a piece of cardboard
5. Put Jesus through the slit, move stick back and forth so he is walking on the water.
