TEST

This test answers the question, "Am I ?"

Do my circumstances determine my level of commitment?

2 Timothy 4:6-8 - For I am already being poured out like a drink offering, and the time for my departure is near. I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith. Now there is in store for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will award to me on that day—and not only to me, but also to all who have longed for his appearing.

Paul's laundry list of challenging circumstances:

Imprisoned frequently, 5 times flogged severely, 3 times beaten with rods, stoned and left for dead, shipwrecked 3 times, spent a night and a day in the open sea, in danger from rivers, bandits, his fellow Jews, Gentiles, in the city, in the country, at sea, and even from false believers, worked diligently, often without sleep, hungry, thirsty, cold and naked. **2 Corinthians 11:23-27**

How are you being tested? Faith should always supersede
