Jonah 1:4-17

### The Story of Jonah in 20 words:

*God decrees, Jonah flees, storm follows, fish swallows, second chances, Jonah advances, God relents, Jonah's lament, Jonah's case, God's grace.*

**Jonah 1:2** - Go to the great city of Nineveh and preach against it, because its wickedness has come up before me.
