## **You Are Going To Die!**

**To open our study of eternity we begin with two facts:**

- 1. You are \_\_\_\_\_.**
- 2. \_\_\_\_\_ goes to Heaven.**

The world offers several explanations of what might happen beyond death.

- A. The Idea of \_\_\_\_\_
- B. The Belief in \_\_\_\_\_
- C. The Resignation to \_\_\_\_\_

The Bible rejects all three of these views. The biblical definition of death is grounded in humankind's relationship to God. Death was the \_\_\_\_\_.

*Genesis 2:17*

*<sup>17</sup>but you must not eat from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, for when you eat of it you will surely die."*

The Bible refers to several different aspect of "death."

- 1. \_\_\_\_\_** - Flesh breaks down.
- 2. \_\_\_\_\_ death-** is the state of being alienated from God.
- 3. \_\_\_\_\_ death-** is a person's final separation from God.

The first death can be one of two things:

- a. It can be the door of entry into eternal \_\_\_\_\_. Eternity with our creator.
- b. It can be the hallway to eternal \_\_\_\_\_. Eternity in absence from God.

**Does everyone ultimately end up in heaven?**

Logical flaw:

Universalism demands that all religious beliefs must be accepted as valid, including those which are the \_\_\_\_\_ of one another.

**Jesus held a different teaching about heaven...Instead of Heaven has a wide gate that includes everybody...**

*Matthew 7:13-14*

*<sup>13</sup>"Enter through the \_\_\_\_\_. For wide is the gate and broad is the road that leads to destruction, and many enter through it. <sup>14</sup>But small is the gate and narrow the road that leads to life, and only a \_\_\_\_\_.*

**Heaven is not a place of \_\_\_\_\_.**

**So, how do we end up in heaven?**

Answer: Through the \_\_\_\_\_, Jesus personally "became sin for us" and provided our only way into heaven by allowing us to become clothed in his perfect merit.

*2 Corinthians 5:21*

*God made him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.*
