Almost all the discrepancies between science and the Bible are not scientific. The real issue is different
Believers begin with the presupposition of Atheists begin with a presupposition of
William Provine of Cornell University - If Darwinism is true, then there are some inescapable conclusions: * There's no evidence for God * There's no ultimate meaning for life * There's no absolute foundation for right and wrong * There's no life after death
The presuppositions of both the Christian and the atheist require
It does require faith to believe that God could make everything out of nothing, but the alternative is believing that nothing turned itself in to everything.
Hebrews 11:6 – And without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to Him must believe that He exists and that He rewards those who earnestly seek Him.
