Excuse -	• <b>3:11 -</b> "Who am I?"
Excuse -	<b>3:13 -</b> "What is His name?"
Excuse -	• <b>4:1 -</b> "What if they don't believe me or listen to me?"
Excuse -	• <b>4:10 -</b> "I have never been eloquent!"
Excuse -	• <b>4:13 -</b> "Lord, please send someone else!"

**Exodus 8:19a** - The magicians said to Pharaoh, "This is the finger of God." (*This followed the* 3<sup>rd</sup> plague of gnats)

**Exodus 14:10-11** - As Pharaoh approached, the Israelites looked up, and there were the Egyptians, marching after them. They were terrified and cried out to the Lord. They said to Moses, "Was it because there were no graves in Egypt that you brought us to the desert to die?"

**Exodus 15:22 & 24** - Then Moses led Israel from the Red Sea and they went into the Desert of Shur. For three days they traveled in the desert without finding water...So the people grumbled against Moses, saying, "What are we to drink?"

**Exodus 16:3** - The Israelites said to them, "If only we had died by the Lord's hand in Egypt! There we sat around pots of meat and ate all the food we wanted, but you have brought us out into this desert to starve this entire assembly to death."

**Exodus 17:1b-2** - They camped at Rephidim, but there was no water for the people to drink. So they quarreled with Moses and said, "Give us water to drink."

**Exodus 12:13** - The blood will be a sign for you on the houses where you are, and when I see the blood, I will pass over you. No destructive plague will touch you when I strike Egypt.

**John 1:29** - The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him and said, "Look, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!"

**Luke 22:19-20** - And he took bread, gave thanks and broke it, and gave it to them, saying, "This is my body given for you; do this in remembrance of me." In the same way, after the supper he took the cup, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood, which is poured out for you."

**1 Corinthians 5:7b-8a** - For Christ, our Passover lamb, has been sacrificed. Therefore, let us keep the Festival...
