No specific method for prayer works for everyone.

**Mark 1:35** - Very early in the morning, while it was still dark, Jesus got up, left the house and went off to a solitary place, where he prayed.

Prayer is much less likely to happen if it's not planned, unless you're in a crisis or a place of great need.

"Is prayer your steering wheel or your spare tire?" - Corrie ten Boom

**Luke 11:1a** - One day Jesus was praying in a certain place.

**Matthew 6:6a** - But when you pray, go into your room, close the door and pray to your Father...

**John 17:1a** - After Jesus said this, he looked toward heaven and prayed...

**Acts 9:40a** – Peter sent them all out of the room; then he got down on his knees and prayed...

Psalm 46:10 - He says, "Be still, and know that I am God..."

**Psalm 131:1-2a** - My heart is not proud, Lord, my eyes are not haughty; I do not concern myself with great matters or things too wonderful for me. But I have calmed and quieted myself...
