Becoming a Conversationalist

John 4:7-26

Approach One: Ask Questions. John 4:7 – When a Samaritan woman came to draw water, Jesus said to her, "Will you give me a drink?"	
Approach Two: Everyone has a John 4:9 – The Samaritan woman said to him, "You are a Jew and I am a Samaritan woman. How can you ask me for a drink?" (For Jews do not associate with Samaritans.)	
Approach Three: Speak to the Person's and	
Approach Four: Connectthe Surface. John 4:16 – He told her, "Go, call your husband and come back."	

Approach Five: Genuine and John 4:21 – "Woman," Jesus replied, "believe me, a time is coming when you will worship the Father neither on this mountain nor in Jerusalem."
Let Them Help You: Start with Them and They Will Point to the Gospel
*Listen to their story *Empathize with their story *Retell their story redemptively
Principle 5: Effective evangelistic conversations connect the gospel with the specific issues people face.
Principle 6: people to be open to the gospel, and learn to share Jesus where they live.
