The problem with grace is that it's	
Romans 3:23-24for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, and all are justified freely by his grace through the redemption that came by Christ Jesus.	
Observations:	
1) The law is beneficial for your time on	
earth, but it can't get you into	
Galatians 3:11 - Clearly no one who relies on the law is justified before God, because "the righteous will live by faith."	
2) The law doesn't make us	
It reminds us that we	
Romans 7:7b - I would not have known what sin was had it not been for the law. For I would not have known what coveting really was if the law had not said, "You shall not covet."	
3) The law doesn't change the heart.
