1 Corinthians 12:12-27

There never was,

anyone else exactly like you.
Your gifts, your talents,
your abilities, your experiences,
your passion, your faith.

You're INDISPENSABLE to the body of Christ.

You're INDISPENSABLE to the body of Christ.
Important Body Dynamics:
* Unity doesn't equal
Vs. 12 - Just as a body, though one, has many parts, but all its many parts form one body, so it is with Christ.
* Diversity can cause
Vs. 15 - Now if the foot should say, "Because I am not a hand, I do not belong to the body," it would not for that reason stop being part of the body.

* Diversity can foster
Vs. 21 - The eye cannot say to the hand, "I don't need you!" And the head cannot say to the feet, "I don't need you!"
* You were made to
make a difference.
Vs. 17 & 19 - If the whole body were an eye, where would the sense of hearing be? If the whole body were an ear, where would the sense of smell be? If they were all one part, where would the body be?
Three keys to making the most of who God designed you to be:

Vs. 18 - But in fact God has placed the parts in the body, every one of them, just as he wanted them to be.

Romans 12:3a - For by the grace given me I say to every one of you: Do not think of yourself more highly than you ought, but rather think of yourself with sober judgment
Humility is not your ability.
Humility is recognizing that how you're designed is not intended to make you famous but to help you serve others.
1 Peter 4:10 - Each of you should use whatever gift you have received to serve others, as faithful stewards of God's grace in its various forms. 3.
2 Corinthians 9:15 - Thanks be to God for his indescribable gift!
