Trust

John 3:16-17

Series goal: To provide tools necessary to make divinely inspired decisions.
One of the most significant challenges people face is also one of the least talked about in churches today:
doubts don't usually go away.
They often grow bigger and stronger.
"Too much of my time has been spent doubting my beliefs and believing my doubts."
It's okay if you're having trouble trusting God.
Hebrews 11:1 - Now faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see.
There is believing as well as doubting inside all of us because we all have the same incomplete information to work with.
2 Corinthians 5:7 - For we live by faith, not by sight.
Clear doesn't always lead to trust.
Luke 16:31 - 31 "He said to him, 'If they do not listen to Moses and the Prophets, they will not be convinced even if someone rises from the dead.""
